Applications are invited for one post of Project Assistant with a fixed amount of Rs. 22,000/- and one post of Field Worker with a fixed amount of Rs. 15,000/- in a Department of Science and Technology, New Delhi sponsored project entitled "Microbial technology dissemination for scaling-up of vegetable cultivation through women participation" (Project code: M-21/211). The posts are temporary, sanctioned for one year and three months and co-terminus with the project. Candidates for Project Assistant should be Graduate in Agriculture (B.Sc. Agri.) or Science (B.Sc.) with Botany or Microbiology as one of the subjects. Upper age limit of the candidates should be 35 years (5 years' relaxation for Female/SC/ST/ Physically Handicapped Candidate, 3 years for OBC candidate). Candidates for Field Worker should be High School (10<sup>th</sup>) pass with at least one year experience in laboratory or field work. Upper age limit of the candidates should be 30 years (5 years' relaxation for Female/SC/ST/ Physically Handicapped Candidate, 3 years for OBC candidate). All things being equal, SC/ST candidates will be preferred as per GOI rules.
